An adventurous spirit at heart, Margie’s travelled off the beaten track in 70+ countries. She’s crossed the Sahara Desert, stayed in Palestinian refugee camps, hiked the Inca trail, swam with piranhas in the Amazon and, perhaps bravest of all, cycled through Beijing. Apart from Australia, she has lived in Papua New Guinea, the US and is now based in Singapore.

When she’s not juggling (and occasionally dropping) many balls as she makes her mark professionally while raising four teenage children, Margie enjoys sharing adventures and travelling the world with them and her husband Andrew—most recently summiting Africa’s tallest peak, Mt Kilimanjaro.
